





Brothers & Sisters:

As we continue our Lenten journey with our Lord Jesus Christ into this second week of Lent, the Gospel of Saint Matthew gives us a glimpse of what we long to see at the end of our earthly life. The Transfiguration of Jesus Christ is indeed a manifestation of what heaven is like.



Before dying on the cross, Jesus wanted His three disciples—Peter, John, and James—to experience how delightful it was to be in the presence of God in heaven. Witnessing the Transfiguration, they were overwhelmed by the radiance of heavenly light and the deep joy that filled their minds and souls. They did not want to leave; they wanted to remain in that spark of heaven. In that moment, nothing in this world could distract or attract them away from such blessedness.

However, to be with the Transfigured Christ, they had to go down the mountain and carry out the mission entrusted to them—a mission that would ultimately lead to Calvary. The path to glory passes through the Cross.

We too, if we desire to be with Jesus in heaven, must make our journey to Calvary. Let us follow in Jesus' footsteps, carrying with us our troubles, burdens, weariness, sorrows, hurts, pain, suffering, addictions, and even our sinfulness, and nail them to the Holy Cross of Christ. Let our deepest longing for heaven become a source of strength and determination along our earthly pilgrimage.

May the heavenly light revealed in the Transfiguration clear away the stumbling blocks in our lives—selfishness, stubbornness, pride, lust, greed, indifference, and all that prevents us from entering the Kingdom of Heaven.

Indeed, at the end of our earthly life, may we be able to say with Peter: “Lord Jesus, it is so good that we are here with You!”


